

Local Author Releases Explosive Book

Shocking revelations regarding threats to national security

Gold Canyon resident and law enforcement expert Dr. Glenn Walp recently released his book, Implosion at Los Alamos, based on his role as head of security at Los Alamos National Labs (LANL) in New Mexico following the 9/11 attacks in New York in 2002.

Retired as Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police, Walp felt the need to serve his country post 9/11. No longer at an age for military service, he was hired to head up the LANL Office of Security Inquiries. He immediately became aware of serious policy and security breaches at LANL that he believed could be putting our country's nuclear weapons secrets and national security in jeopardy; many of which remain unresolved even today.

Walp and second-in-command Steve Doran uncovered millions of dollars in thefts, major security breaches, missing computers, corruption and cover-ups at the very facility that was entrusted with our national nuclear security secrets – secrets that could very well now be in

the hands of our enemies.

Determined to stop the sieve of information leaking from the lab, Walp and Doran implemented policy and procedure changes designed to halt the flow of thefts and security breaches. Try as

they might, their efforts were stymied by lab officials who were content with things the way they were and who feared any negative publicity would jeopardize their positions. Walp and Doran were told to halt their efforts or risk losing their jobs.

Faced with choosing between national security and job security, Walp and Doran decided to put national security ahead of their pocketbooks and continued with their efforts, which eventually lead to the loss of their jobs, a lengthy legal battle, three congressional hearings and an inquiry by the U.S. Department of Energy into national labs across the country.


Walp says his quest in releasing Implosion at Los Alamos is to bring the ongoing problem with national security to the attention of President Obama and other leaders so appropriate steps can be taken to protect nuclear weapons secrets from falling into the hands of countries and factions ill-equipped to handle the enormity of the associated knowledge and power.
